JV Rider Football

Thursday, October 4th may have seemed, to the casual observer, like another typical day at the Ranch. By nightfall, however, it had proved to be an historic day in the life of the JV Rider football team. Playing some of their best football of the season, the JV team cruised to a 28-16 victory over White Deer. By most accounts, this is the first JV football victory in three years. Using a potent ground attack on offense and some hard-hitting defense the Riders dominated the game from start to finish allowing White Deer scores only on two of their last three possessions of the game.

The Riders had success running the football with Zac Bolton carrying the ball 3 times for 80 yards which included one touchdown and a two point conversion. Bobby Nichols added 19 carries for 89 yards that tallied 3 touchdowns and a two point conversion.

Defensively, the Riders all, but shutdown the White Deer attack. Anthony Davis played his best game of the season with 4 tackles. DeJon Haye added four tackles of his own and had 3 quarterback hurries to his credit. Colton Richie recovered one fumble and Tucker Massingill had one interception.

The JV Roughriders are preparing for a rematch with the Greyhounds of Gruver on Thursday, October 11th.
